Glossary of Terms

HL – Higher Level courses (3 semesters in length)
SL – Standard Level courses (2 semesters in length)
TOK – Theory of Knowledge course
EE – Extended Essay (4000 word essay diploma requirement)
CAS – Creative/Action and Service Diploma Requirement
IB Diploma- Earned after successful completion of 6 IB courses (3 SL and 3 HL), EE, TOK and CAS
Diploma Programme Course (formerly Certificate)
 Earned after the successful completion of an IB course by students who do not meet all of the requirements of the full Diploma Programme.
